

# TOURNAMENT RULES



### **GUEST CODE OF CONDUCT:**

The Women's Flat Track Derby Association strives to provide a safe and satisfying event for everyone in attendance by seeking your compliance with our guest code of conduct. We ask for your assistance in creating an environment that is free of:

- Abusive or foul language and obscene gestures directed toward other guests, venue employees, tournament staff and volunteers, players, coaches, and officials.
- Guests who are disruptive to the event or impair other guests' enjoyment.
- Intoxicated or drug-impaired individuals.
- Smoking, except in designated areas (located outside of the arena).
- Prohibited entry items such as outside food & beverage, weapons, non-service animals, air horns, vuvuzelas, megaphones, and laser pointers, and other


- items deemed inappropriate, harmful or hazardous by tournament staff.
- Professional cameras, video cameras, and audio recorders without prior authorization and proper credentials.
- Guests without proper authorization or credentials entering or attempting to enter restricted areas.
- Banners or signs that obstruct the view of guests, obscure sponsor advertising, contain objectionable subject matter, or are commercial in nature. The WFTDA and the venue reserve the right to remove any banner or sign at any time.

Guests not abiding by this Guest Code of Conduct are subject to ejection from the venue. In the event that you are refused entry into or requested to leave the venue for failure to comply with the Guest Code of Conduct or follow the venue regulations, you will not be entitled to a replacement or refund for your ticket. Entry to the venue shall constitute acceptance of the Guest Code of Conduct and venue regulations.

### PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF A FEW **TOURNAMENT RULES**:

- No video or audio recording devices or cameras with detachable lenses without prior approval from the WFTDA. Please visit wftda.com/tournaments/ credentials for more information.
- Live streaming video of the games, including on social media platforms such as Periscope and Livestream on Facebook Live, is prohibited.
- If you choose to sit trackside, you accept all responsibility for the possible risk of injury to you or damage and/or destruction to your belongings at any time without warning. Trackside seating is at your own risk.
- Chairs are not permitted trackside except as a companion to ADA accessible seating. Wheelchairs (and their companion chair) must be a minimum of five feet away from the outside referee lane.
- Glassware, sharp objects, and other items deemed inappropriate, harmful, or hazardous by tournament staff are not allowed in trackside seating.
- Fire lanes, exits, and walkways must remain clear.

- You must remain seated in the trackside seating area. Laying down is not permitted. Keep your hands, feet, and belongings behind the safety line at all times. Do not touch or grab Skaters or Officials who fall into trackside seating. If a piece of clothing or equipment falls onto the track, do not enter the track or safety lane to retrieve it.
- Certain areas of the track and venue are reserved for individuals who require special seating or perform specific game duties. They may obstruct the view of persons behind them. However, they are not able to move, sit, squat, or otherwise alter their position lest they not be able to complete their job function.
- By entering the venue, you agree to the possibility of being photographed, filmed, or recorded. Your voice, image and likeness may be captured and recorded in and around the venue and publicly disseminated by any means and in any format or media. You waive all rights on an irrevocable, worldwide, perpetual basis to object to such recording and dissemination.

#### **PARKING**

There is a paid parking (12\$/day) in front of the venue. Finding free street parking in the area is not easy, so we recommend taking public transport.

#### SECURITY

There will be hired security personnel and volunteer security staff from the Montréal Roller Derby League to attend to crowd control and general security matters. You are advised not to leave valuables unattended as neither the WFTDA, the Montréal Roller Derby League, nor the Centre Pierre-Charbonneau will be responsible for loss, damage, or theft of your belongings. Any property you bring to the event is at your own risk.

#### **FOOD AND BEVERGE**

No outside food or beverage will be allowed into the venue.

#### **RULES AND RESTRICTIONS**

- All purses, bags and cases are subject to search.
- In accordance with the Centre Pierre-Charbonneau ordinances, smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not permitted in all public areas at the Centre Pierre-Charbonneau including the arena and concourse. A designated outdoor smoking area will be provided.

- or illegal, or that may be used as a weapon, compromise or otherwise interfere with the enjoyment, comfort, or safety of any person or pose risk to security at the venue, or any other item that WFTDA event officials or the Centre Pierre-Charbonneau officials determine (in their absolute discretion) may cause injury or public nuisance or inconvenience to any other person is strictly prohibited.
- No animals other than guide, signal, or service animals (as defined by law) are allowed in the Centre Pierre-Charbonneau. All sanitary needs for permitted animals are the responsibility of the customer.
- WFTDA, nor the Montréal Roller Derby League, will be liable for any loss, damage, or harm (of any kind, including to any person or any property) arising from your presence at the event and you agree that no claim, complaint, or proceeding will be brought in this regard. You are responsible for any property you bring to the event and such property is at your own risk. Your presence and/or movement in and around the event is at your own risk.

Two 14-skater teams play two 30-minute periods. Each period consists of multiple "jams." Each jam is an opportunity for both teams to score points. A jam lasts two minutes unless the Lead Jammer calls it off herself.

It is legal for a player to block her opponents with her hips, rear, and shoulders. It is not legal to block to the back, to trip, or to elbow another skater. Players committing illegal actions go to the penalty box for 30 seconds while their team plays short.

Jam Start

Each team fields 4 Blockers and 1 Jammer, Blockers attempt to take the position most advantageous for their Jammer while setting up to block the opposing Jammer. Play starts with a single whistle blast.

Second Pass

In subsequent passes, Jammers earn 1 point for each opposing player they pass legally. The opposing Blockers will try to stop the Jammer, while helping their own Jammer through the pack.

First Pass

During the first pass, the first Jammer to pass all in-play Blockers in the pack legally is Lead Jammer. Lead Jammer status is signaled by the officials blowing two short whistle blasts and pointing at the Lead Jammer.

2014 Women's Flat Track Decby Association (WFTDA)



Jammers wear a star on their helmets and are the scoring players for each team. The Jammers attempt to pass the opponents as many times as possible by sprinting around the track and lapping the pack.

### PIVOT

The Pivot is the Blocker that wears the stripe on her head. She is the only Blocker that is allowed to accept a star pass from the Jammer, thus becoming the new Jammer and gaining the ability to score points.

### BLOCKER

The Blockers are simultaneously focused on stopping the opposing Jammer from passing them and assisting their Jammer to pass the opposing team's Blockers. The pack is formed by the largest group of Blockers with players from each team on the track











Multiplayer Block





# THINGS TO DO IN MONTRÉAL

Here are some fun things to do in our beautiful city! We also highly recommend picking a neighborhood like the Mile End, HoMa or Saint-Henri to just walk around and take in your surroundings

The world-renowned Montreal Biodome, Botanical Garden and Insectarium are only minutes away from the venue. The Biodome allows visitors to walk through four ecosystems from the Americas, including both flora and fauna; our Botanical Garden is considered to be one of the most important in the world; and the Insectarium is the largest insect museum in North America.

**Old Montréal** and the **Old Port** are a prime sightseeing spot! It's the oldest section of the city, a reminder of our New France past. While you could wander its streets for hours, you'll also find the

Marché Bonsecours (local arts and crafts), Notre-Dame Basilica, and the Pointe-à-Callières Museum of Archeology and History.

The Montreal Museum of Fine Arts' four pavilions, situated in the city's historic Golden Square Mile, contain more than 41,000 works of art. This includes pieces from the Middle Ages to the modern days from around the world, as well as archeological remains. One of its main collections focuses on Quebec and Canadian art. It also welcomes traveling exhibits from places as diverse as the Getty Museum, the Musée Rodin and the Metropolitan Museum of Art.

# WHERE TO EAT IN MONTRÉAL
