2022 – A year of evolution & change A Snapshot

- First year since 2009 without an Executive Director
- Small core staff contingent supervised by BoD
- WFTDA declared a surplus
- WFTDA, WFTDI & Quad Media run by independent boards
- ART Project Report Received
- Competitive play overhauled
- Began rebuilding membership post COVID-19
 - 380 member leagues (additional 54 B & C teams registered)
- Reassessed the COVID-19 return to play accessibility and ART principals
- Cleared Grievance Backlog BoD led
- BoD has more International members than American members



Competitive Play re-imagined – key points

- Moved to an 18-month cycle
- Regional Cups & Hydra-Style Competition
- Focused on regional gameplay
- Space for both regional and international gameplay (GUR)
- Robustly interrogating the fragility of rankings
- Allowed for more than one team per league to be ranked (B's & C's etc.)
- Amended Charter regulations players allowed on 2 charters simultaneously

Grievance Committee

- Grievance was paused pre-pandemic owing to volunteer burnout
- BoD reengaged grievance in 21/22 and closed outstanding grievances
- Began discussing the restructure of grievance with focus on:
 - Empowering leagues to handle grievances effectively
 - Equipping members and leagues with resources and education
 - Sharing inter organisational data on suspended individuals (WFTDA/JRDA/MRDA)
 - Conversations to understand volunteer capacities within grievance
- Currently processing new grievances as needed

WFTDA Structure

- Simplify structure and membership pillars with clear lines of reporting to BoD
- Establish/firm up the relationships with NGBs/RGBs and work hand in hand
- Regular Round-Tables & Feedback

 Help Wanted: Operational/Strategic Planning specialists (BoD Position)



WFTDA Structure cont.

Grievance:

- Restructure with assistance from experts, RGBs
 & NGBs
- Focus on education and provision of resources
- Partner with International organisations who are specialists in mediation and conflict resolution
- Shift towards restorative justice vs punitive outcomes (where possible)
- Help Wanted: Mediators/Councilors/Conflict Resolution specialists (BoD and Committee Positions)

Membership Engagement

- Deep dive into understanding the life cycle of membership
- Understand Membership experiences throughout the life cycle, to create intentional membership at all stages - ensuring that this includes officials and other volunteers
- Create a volunteer drive and plan
- Regular regional and membership roundtables and Town Halls.

Membership Engagement cont.

- Officiating recruitment, engagement and retention plan
- Strong and engaging member services across all aspects of membership
- Help Wanted: Member engagement/ Employee Engagement/People's Person (BoD Position)

Competitive Play

- Implementation & review of the new structure
- Further develop new sanctioning system
- Officiating Accessibility, Opportunity, Equality & Education

Help Wanted:

- Competitive Play Volunteers
- Regional Cup/Tournament Hosts
- Announcers (live/on-site and Remote Studio)

Educational Resources

- Ensure that opportunities and resources are available to all -Skaters and officials alike
- Create tools for membership
- Risk management resources
- Ensure that they are easy to find and easy to understand (language and simplicity)
- Help Wanted:
 - An educator who is familiar with WFTDA systems and can assist with oversight of the education pillar (BoD Position)
 - Librarian (appointed position) assist in locating, cataloguing and accessing resources (BoD Position)

Educational Resources

Visibility

- Create resources to assist leagues in promoting roller derby
- Build bigger fanbases and explore avenues of exposure for the sport
- Create champaigns that assist leagues in roller derby recruitment
- Build media and video champaigns with WFTDA.TV
