

WFTDA NON-SKATING OFFICIAL SHIRT SELF-PRINT INSTRUCTIONS

UPDATED AUGUST 2018

The following are instructions on how to get your Non-Skating Official's shirt printed locally in your area.

This design is NOT for commercial purposes.

Back of Shirt

The back of the shirt will have the word OFFICIAL printed in white ink on the upper back of the shirt. The size should be 1.5 inches high x 10 inches wide (3.81 centimeters high x 25.4 centimeters wide).



Sleeve of Shirt

The shirt will have the word OFFICIAL printed in white ink on the bottom of the left sleeve. The size should be .4 inches high x 3.5 inches wide (1.016 centimeters high x 8.89 centimeters wide).

The Details

The WFTDA is providing the following uniform shirt guidelines for Non-Skating Officials as a free download, with graphics and specifications for individual printing on a standard black t-shirt or black polo. *These designs are not to be used for commercial use.*

You may not print any form of the WFTDA logo on this (or any) shirt. If you would like an officiating t-shirt or polo with the WFTDA logo printed on it, you can purchase on here in our online store. If you would like, you may sew a patch from any member league, MRDA, JRDA or WFTDA governing body membership patch as needed onto the left front chest of the shirt.

The printing guidelines outlined in this document should be followed expressly without changes. Page 1 of this document outlines where the member patch must be placed on the front of the shirt.

Front of Shirt Example

The following is an example of the where the WFTDA patch should be placed. It is located on the upper left chest of the shirt. The WFTDA logo **SHOULD NOT** be printed on the shirt.

- DO NOT use any other font than what is provided in this file. The text on the last two pages are provided to you in a vector format at the appropriate size.
- DO NOT print the words in any other color than white.
- DO NOT put the word official on the opposite sleeve. It should always be on the left sleeve.
