HOW TO GET TO MALMÖ AND THE HOTEL

TO MALMÖ

BY AIR

The easiest and probably cheapest airport is Copenhagen Airport Kastrup, Denmark. From there you can easily take the train over to Malmö (around 100 SEK/~12 USD). You buy the train ticket from ticket machines. The train stops at Hyllie, Triangeln (the one closest to the venue) and Malmö Centralstation. Information about trains: www.skanetrafiken.se.

You can also fly to Malmö Airport. From there you can take the airport bus to Malmö (around 100 SEL/~12 USD) or take a taxi (around 500 SEK/~60 USD). Information about the airport coach: www.flygbussarna.se/malmo

BY TRAIN

Malmö Centralstation (Malmö C) is located in downtown Malmö at Skeppsbron 1, 211 20 Malmö. When arriving from Copenhagen via the train, the closest station to the venue is Triangeln Station.

BY CAR

It is possible to rent a car at Copenhagen Airport and drive over the Öresund bridge to get to Malmö, Sweden. It is a 30-minute drive from city to city.

TO THE HOTEL

FROM COPENHAGEN AIRPORT (CPH)

Take the Öresund train to Malmö Hyllie Station. From Hyllie you can take bus 6 (direction: Toftanäs) and jump of at Malmö Södertorp.

Bus 999 drives directly from Copenhagen Airport to Stadiongatan in Malmö—the same street that Good Morning+ hotel (the host hotel) is located on. www.graahundbus.dk

BY CAR

The hotel is 1 km from the highways E4, E6, and E20. Take exit Svågertorp toward Malmö C and Hospital (Sjukhus). Follow Trelleborgsvägen and take a left turn at the first traffic light toward Stadiongatan. Pass two traffic lights and the hotel is on your right side.

FROM CENTRAL STATION (MALMÖ CENTRAL)

The closest bus stop is Södertorp. The buses passing by here are bus 6 and 34. Plan your journey using the Skånetrafikens webpage: **www.skanetrafiken.se**

FROM TRIANGELN STATION

Take the north exit to get to the buses. Here you can take bus 6 (Direction toward Klagshamn) and jump of at the bus stop Södertorp.

HOW TO GET TO THE VENUE

- Head east on Stadiongatan toward Arkitektgatan (6 m)
 - Gå österut på Stadiongatan mot Arkitektgatan
- Turn left onto Bisittaregatan (87 m)
 - Sväng vänster in på Bisittaregatan
- Slight left to stay on Bisittaregatan (19 m)
 - Lite vänster för att stanna på Bisittaregatan
- Turn left onto Eric Perssons väg (43 m) Destination will be on the left
 - Sväng vänster mot Eric Perssons väg Destinationen kommer till vänster

PARKING

There are plenty of parking spaces around Baltiska hallen. There is a big car park (P-huset Stadion) next to the venue where you can park your car for 10 sek/h.

SECURITY

There will be hired security personnel and volunteer security staff from the Crime City Rollers to attend to crowd control and general security matters. You are advised not to leave valuables unattended as neither the WFTDA, the Crime City Rollers, nor the Baltiska hallen will be responsible for loss, damage, or theft of your belongings. Any property you bring to the event is at your own risk.

There will be food to buy inside the venue and there is a big grocery store just around the corner where you can buy salads and such. Outside food is not permitted in the venue.

SEATING INFORMATION

- Seating is on a first come, first served basis. There will be stadium seating and limited track-side floor seating. No reserved seating or VIP seating is offered for this tournament.
- No carry-in chairs are permitted.
- Chairs are not permitted trackside except as a companion to ADA accessible seating. Wheelchairs (and their companion chair) must be a minimum of five feet away from the outside referee line.
- In order to sit trackside, you must be at least 18 years old. If you do not have a valid photo ID to verify your age, you will be required to move.
- We expect high attendance at the tournament and seating areas to be full. Do not "save seats" for individuals who are not returning to their seats momentarily. You will be asked to remove skate bags, backpacks, and other large items from the seating area in order to make room to accommodate others. Participant bags may be left in the participant-only area (locker rooms). Please be considerate and allow others to sit if a seat is not actively being occupied.


ENTRY AND RE-ENTRY

Doors open daily at 9:00 AM. Games begin at 10:00 AM.

Your tickets will be scanned and/or taken at the entrance to the arena. For same day re-entry, you will need a wristband. Do not leave the arena without a wristband if you wish to re-enter.

NOTES AND ADDITIONAL FEES

- Convenience and handling fees are added to these prices (typically by phone or online).
- Friday and Saturday evening tickets are for entry at 5:00 PM (17:00).
- Sunday evening tickets are for entry at 3:00 PM (15:00).
- Discounts for active military personnel are available in person wherever tickets are sold.
- Children 8 years old and younger are always free with a ticketed and supervising adult! While admission is free for children 8 years old and younger, a child ticket will be required upon entry to track venue capacity, so please be sure to obtain one from the ticketing site.



WFTDA TOURNAMENT RULES

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF A FEW TOURNAMENT RULES

- No video or audio recording devices or cameras with detachable lenses without prior approval from the WFTDA. Please visit wftda.com/tournaments/ credentials for more information.
- If you choose to sit trackside, you accept all responsibility for the possible risk of injury to you, or damage and/ or destruction to your belongings at any time without warning. Trackside seating is at your own risk.
- Chairs are not permitted trackside except as a companion to ADA accessible seating. Wheelchairs (and their companion chair) must be a minimum of five feet away from the outside referee lane.
- Glassware, sharp objects, and other items deemed inappropriate, harmful, or hazardous by tournament staff are not allowed in trackside seating.
- You must remain seated in the trackside seating area. Laying down is not permitted. Keep your hands, feet, and belongings behind the safety line at all times. Do not touch or grab skaters or officials who fall into trackside seating. If a piece of clothing or equipment falls onto the track, do not enter the track or safety lane to retrieve it.
- · Fire lanes, exits, and walkways must remain clear.
- Certain areas of the track and venue are reserved for individuals who require special seating or perform specific game duties. They may obstruct the view of persons behind them. However, they are not able to move, sit, squat, or otherwise alter their position lest they not be able to complete their job function.
- By entering the venue, you agree to the possibility of being photographed, filmed, or recorded. Your voice, image, and likeness may be captured and recorded in and around the venue and publicly disseminated by any means and in any format or media. You waive all rights on an irrevocable,

GUEST CODE OF CONDUCT

The Women's Flat Track Derby Association strives to provide a safe and satisfying event for everyone in attendance by seeking your compliance with our guest code of conduct. We ask for your assistance in creating an environment that is free of:

- Abusive or foul language and obscene gestures directed toward other guests, venue employees, tournament staff and volunteers, players, coaches, and officials.
- Guests who are disruptive to the event or impair other guests' enjoyment.
- Intoxicated or drug-impaired individuals.
- Smoking, except in designated areas (located outside of the arena).
- Prohibited entry items such as outside food and beverage, weapons, non-service animals, air horns, vuvuzelas, megaphones, and laser pointers, and other items deemed inappropriate, harmful, or hazardous by tournament staff.
- Professional cameras, video cameras, and audio recorders are prohibited without prior authorization and proper credentials.
- Guests without proper authorization or credentials entering or attempting to enter restricted areas.
- Banners or signs that obstruct the view of guests, obscure sponsor advertising, contain objectionable subject matter, or are commercial in nature. The WFTDA and the venue reserve the right to remove any banner or sign at any time.

Guests not abiding by this Guest Code of Conduct are subject to ejection from the venue. In the event that you are refused entry into or requested to leave the venue for failure to comply with the Guest Code of Conduct or follow the venue regulations, you will not be entitled to a replacement or refund for your ticket. Entry to the venue shall constitute acceptance of the Guest Code of Conduct and venue regulations.

SIGN IN & LACE UP

REGISTRATION

Registration will be at the Baltiska hallen on Thursday, September 7, from 5:00 PM to 10:00 PM (17:00 - 22:00) at which time skaters, officials, and other credentialed participants will complete required paperwork and receive their tournament credentials.

Pre-tournament Meeting will be at the Baltiska hallen on Thursday at 8:00 PM (20:00) local time with the Officials Meeting immediately following.

Credentials must be worn at all times in order to obtain access to the venue and to participant-only areas. There is a \$30 (~244 SEK/€26) fee to replace lost or stolen credentials.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The WFTDA as tournament host provides trained, certified emergency medical responders should an injury occur on the track. These staff may be a contracted service, venue provided, volunteers, and and/or team/league professionals. Only the staffed responders working their current shift may go onto the track or players' benches to access or treat a skater or official. Once removed from the playing area, if the skater or official wishes to use their own medical provider, they may refuse additional treatment.

Team/League medical staff seeking to treat their skaters on the track or bench must be part of, and sit with, the scheduled medical crew. For information on how to volunteer for the safety staff, please let your team's wrangler know so that they can notify the Safety Liaison. PLEASE NOTE: NOT ALL VENUES AND CONTRACTS PERMIT THE USE OF ADDITIONAL OR VOLUNTEER MEDICAL STAFF. The opportunity to participate in this capacity is not guaranteed and when not part of the prearranged schedule will not be permitted.

TEAM ROOMS

Team areas will be based on the tournament schedule and assigned accordingly.

TRACK FLOOR, WARM-UP SPACE, AND WARM-UP TIMES

The track floor is sport court. Teams will be assigned an on-track warm up slot in accordance with seeding. Warm up times will be determined and relayed to the teams by the GTO and noted on the final master schedule.

EVENT TRANSPORTATION

Malmö is big city in a small country, which means you can come a long way by foot. Stroll around in town for a while. From the city center it takes around 25 minutes to walk to the venue.

BUSES AND TRAINS

Skånetrafiken (www.skanetrafiken.se) runs the buses and trains. You can't pay with cash on the green colored buses, so buy a JoJo card at Skånetrafiken at Malmö C, Triangeln train station or a Pressbyrån or a 7/11 convenience store. One bus journey is about 25 SEK (~3 USD/2.60 EUR).

When arriving to Malmö by train, Triangeln station is closest to the venue (25-min walk). From there you can also take bus 6 to the venue. The bus stop is Malmö Borgmästaregården.

If you arrive to Malmö Central Station you can take bus 3 to venue. The bus stop is Malmö Stadion.

INFORMATION ON POWER OUTLET ADAPTERS

The electrical system in Europe is different from the system in North America in two ways: the shape of the plug and the voltage of the current.

North American appliances run on 110 volts, whereas it's 220 volts in Europe. Nowadays, electrical gadgets are dual voltage, meaning they work on both European or American current. If your item has a range of voltages printed on the item or its plug (for example, "110-220"), you'll be OK using your item in Europe. If your item has a voltage switch marked 110 (US) and 220 (Europe), be sure to switch it to 220 before you plug it in in Europe. There are some older American appliances/gadgets that are not equipped to deal with the differing voltages at all (older hair dryers or irons, for example). For those items, you'll need a voltage converter.

What you will need to plan for though, is the actual plug. To use a wall socket in Sweden, you'll need an adapter. You can purchase an American → European plug adapter in many major department stores, on Amazon, or in most travel stores (Rei, Brookstone, etc). And, if you happen to forget to pack an electrical plug adapter, ask the front desk at your hotel. Many times, they have a collection of converters that they allow patrons to borrow during their stays.

This is also where you could find the 190-m high landmark Turning Torso and the outdoor skate park Stapelbäddsparken (Stapelbäddsgatan 3). The park consists of a bowl landscape and a roller derby track. After skating you can go to Scaniabadet for a swim. It is a very popular beach location in Malmö with wooden piers to jump from. Enjoy the sun on wide sundeck or take a bath from one of the three jetties.

THE CASTLE

The Castle is the oldest surviving Renaissance castle in the Nordic region. The castle houses Malmö Museums with an aquarium and exhibitions that deal with history, technology, shipping, and nature. You can also find Malmö Art Museum, the Governor's House and the Castle Mill here. +46 (40) 34 44 00
