


























Guest Code of Conduct

The Women's Flat Track Derby Association strives to provide a safe and satisfying event for everyone in attendance by seeking your compliance with our Guest Code of Conduct. We ask for your assistance in creating an environment that is free of:


- Abusive or foul language and obscene gestures directed toward other guests, venue employees, tournament staff and volunteers, players, coaches, and officials.
- Guests who are disruptive to the event or impair other guests' enjoyment.
- Intoxicated or drug-impaired individuals.
- Smoking, except in designated areas (located outside of the arena).
- Professional cameras, video cameras, and audio recorders are prohibited without prior authorization and proper credentials.

- Prohibited entry items such as outside food and beverage, weapons, non-service animals, air horns, vuvuzelas, megaphones, and laser pointers, and other items deemed inappropriate, harmful, or hazardous by tournament staff.
- Guests without proper authorization or credentials entering or attempting to enter restricted areas.
- Banners or signs that obstruct the view of guests, obscure sponsor advertising, contain objectionable subject matter, or are commercial in nature. The WFTDA and the venue reserve the right to remove any banner or sign at any time.

Guests not abiding by this Guest Code of Conduct are subject to ejection from the venue. In the event that you are refused entry into or requested to leave the venue for failure to comply with the Guest Code of Conduct or follow the venue regulations, you will not be entitled to a replacement or refund for your ticket. Entry to the venue shall constitute acceptance of the Guest Code of Conduct and venue regulations.

Tournament Rules

- All purses, bags, and cases are subject to search.
- In accordance with ShoWare Center ordinances, smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not permitted in all public areas at the ShoWare Center including the arena and concourse. A designated outdoor smoking area is located outside of Section 112. Washington state law prohibits smoking within 25 feet of entrances, exits, and operable windows of any building. Any Guest Service staff member can assist with directing you to the smoking section for that event.
- Any item that is dangerous, hazardous, and/or illegal, or that may be used as a weapon, compromise, or otherwise interfere with the enjoyment, comfort, or safety of any person or pose risk to security at the venue, or any other item that WFTDA event officials or ShoWare Center officials determine (in their absolute discretion) may cause injury or public nuisance or inconvenience to any other person is strictly prohibited.
- No animals other than guide, signal, or service animals (as defined by law) are allowed in ShoWare Center.
 All sanitary needs for permitted animals are the responsibility of the customer.
- Neither the ShoWare Center, the WFTDA, nor Rat City Roller Derby will be liable for any loss, damage, or harm (of any kind, including to any person or any property) arising from your presence at the event and you agree that no claim, complaint, or proceeding will be brought in this regard. You are responsible for any property you bring to the event and such property is at your own risk. Your presence and/or movement in and around the event is at your own risk.

SEED 4

Two 14-skater teams play two 30-minute periods. Each period consists of multiple "jams." Each jam is an opportunity for both teams to score points. A jam lasts two minutes unless the Lead Jammer calls it off herself.

It is legal for a player to block her opponents with her hips, rear, and shoulders. It is not legal to block to the back, to trip, or to elbow another skater. Players committing illegal actions go to the penalty box for 30 seconds while their team plays short.

Jam Start

Each team fields 4 Blockers and 1 Jammer. Blockers attempt to take the position most advantageous for their Jammer while setting up to block the opposing Jammer. Play starts with a single whistle blast.

Second Pass

In subsequent passes, Jammers earn 1 point for each opposing player they pass legally. The opposing Blockers will try to stop the Jammer, while helping their own Jammer through the pack.

During the first pass, the first Jammer to pass all in-play Blockers in the pack legally is Lead Jammer. Lead Jammer status is signaled by the officials blowing two short whistle blasts and pointing at the Lead Jammer.

Jammers wear a star on their helmets and are the scoring players for each team. The Jammers attempt to pass the opponents as many times as possible by sprinting around the track and lapping the pack.

PIVOT

The Pivot is the Blocker that wears the stripe on her head. She is the only Blocker that is allowed to accept a star pass from the Jammer, thus becoming the new Jammer and gaining the ability to score points.

BLOCKER

The Blockers are simultaneously focused on stopping the opposing Jammer from passing them and assisting their Jammer to pass the opposing team's Blockers. The pack is formed by the largest group of Blockers with players from each team on the track

In addition, an elite group of skaters are chosen each year to represent the league on its travel teams, the Rat City All Stars, ranked 16th in the world at the date of this publication, and the Rain of Terror (RCRG's B Team). RCRG also offers several programs for skater development: the learn-to-skate program called Pinkies, Rat Lab Fundamentals, and Competitive Rat Lab, which is RCRG's pool of draft-ready skaters.






