



WFTDA Tournament Skater Uniform Requirements

The following Skater uniform requirements are mandatory for all WFTDA Playoffs, Championships, and Continental Cup tournaments. Any team who is unable to fulfill the uniform guidelines may be required to forfeit their game. League-run tournaments may choose to adopt and enforce this policy, with the exception of the WFTDA patch requirement. Updated April 2018.

Uniform Requirements and Selection

1. Uniforms must conform to requirements in [The Rules of Flat Track Roller Derby](#) and the [WFTDA Sanctioning Policy](#).
2. Each team must have at least one uniform with a white base color and one uniform of a color other than and highly contrasting to white.
3. When rosters are submitted to the Games Tournament Oversight officer (GTO), the higher-seed team will choose which color they will wear for the upcoming game. The lower seed will then choose a uniform color in high contrast to, and a different color than, the higher seed's uniform choice. For example, if the higher seed chooses navy blue, the lower seed cannot choose light blue; another high-contrast color would be acceptable.
 - a. The GTO and Tournament Head Referee (THR) will have final approval over high contrast between opponents' uniforms.
4. In order for a Skater to participate, they must wear a WFTDA patch per the membership requirements set forth in the [WFTDA Bylaws](#).
 - a. Actual WFTDA patches must be worn — to ensure color and brand consistency, patches may not be sublimated (i.e. printed into the uniform).
 - b. All patches must be sewn on — no safety pins or tape will be allowed.

Helmet Covers

1. Helmet covers must meet all guidelines set forth in [The Rules of Flat Track Roller Derby](#) and the [WFTDA Sanctioning Policy](#).
2. Each team must have a set of white helmet covers for use with the white uniform.

Revisions

April 2018:

Split Uniform Policy into separate document.

Changed uniform requirements to require only a white uniform in addition to the requirements in the WFTDA Sanctioning Policy.

June 2017:

Updated uniform policy to match updates for 2017 Rules of Flat Track Roller Derby and updated approval process for tournament uniforms so pre-approval not required.
